## Hintz for Assembly Campaign Update

Dear Friends,

I hope you had a chance to see the League of Women Voter's 54th Assembly District debate. I'm proud to highlight my work in the legislature, and I have to give my opponent credit for speaking candidly at the forum.

Unfortunately, my opponent's candor also painted a bleak picture of our state under the extreme policies he's proposing:

- My opponent said in no uncertain terms he wants to eliminate SeniorCare, Wisconsin's prescription drug program for seniors, while drastically rolling back BadgerCare at a time when it is needed most.
- He said he wants to reinstate a corporate tax loophole that will choke off shared revenue to cities across the state and all but guarantee increases in property taxes on Wisconsin's middle class.
- He even wants to delay construction projects in Wisconsin, laying off construction workers and potentially leaving our highways riddled with pot holes and half-finished buildings on campuses like UW-O for at least two years.

Oshkosh has a clear choice this election between a state government that works for the people and one that passes the buck to Wisconsin's municipalities.
